The Mass sport Committee of the Russian Skating Union (RSU) and Speed Skating Center “Kolomna” hereby takes the pleasure to invite you to take part in:

30th Masters’ International Allround Games Kolomna, Russia, February 19 - 20, 2022

The competition will be held according to the Constitutions and Regulations of the International Masters’ Speed Skating Committee (IMSSC) and the International Skating Union (ISU). The competition takes place at the covered 400m standard track of Speed Skating Center “Kolomna” (Moscow Region) on artificial ice. This competition is an event on the International Masters’ Calendar 2021/2022 of the IMSSC.

1. Number of Competitors – No Quota

This is a two-days Allround competition. It is open to Master Ladies and Men starting from 30 age group upward (as necessary).

The competition is limited to 250 competitors. Registrations will begin on October 11th and the chronological order of registration will be taken into account. If the competitors registered are more than 250, a waiting list is foreseen in the registration system. In case a skater withdraws his/her registration, he/she may be substituted by a skater from a waiting list. There is no Quota of Entries for the different Nations.

2. Age Groups

The competitions take place in five year age groups as follows:

3. Eligibility

To be eligible, a skater must be a member of a National Speed Skating Federation recognized by the ISU, and must have a license of his/her Federation.

4. Distances

Ladies (age group 30 and higher): 500m, 1,500m, 1,000m, 3,000m;

Men (age group 30-60): 500m, 3,000m, 1,500m, 5,000m;

Men (age group 65 and higher): 500m, 1,500m, 1,000m, 3,000m.

Quartet start may be used for all distances except 500m.

The A Pattern of Sub-Rule 3.1.1, Masters' International Allround Games, of IMSSC Constitution & Regulations will be followed, consisting in the following structure:

Days	Men, 30-60 AG	Ladies / Men, 65+ AG
First Day	500m 3,000m	500m 1,500m
Second Day	1,500m 5,000m	1,000m 3,000m

Every skater that has finalized three distances according to IMSSC and ISU rules is allowed to skate the fourth and longest distance.

5. Limit times

According to Rule 3.1.6, every participant has to inform his national IMSSC Member about his/her most recent time in the 1.500m distance. It is the responsibility of the national IMSSC Member to accept times.

If the applicable time does not meet the maximum time as laid down in the table below (Maximum Time Table), the participant cannot take part in the Allround Games, unless the national IMSSC Member decides otherwise in a written consent.

6.2 Training and Warm Up Times

A daily admittance fee must be paid 5,00 Euro (for each session), unless on Friday February 18th (16.00 –18.00 official training) and on all competition days.

7. Drawing & Classification

On the first two distances of the Allround Games, the skaters shall be seeded in three groups before drawing, according to their best times of the season, their best times of last season, or their estimated times. The seeding occurs per Age Group or per joined Age Groups.

Drawing at the Masters' International Allround Games will be done according to ISU Rule 244 for Drawing at International Competitions. For drawing, the ISU Rule 244, Paragraphs 3, 4 and 5 apply, as well as ISU Rule 240, Paragraph 2.

For drawing of Masters' International Allround Games generally the age groups are drawn separately. If the number of competitors is very small in one or several of the five year age groups, neighbored 5 year age groups may be joined for drawing and speedskating. But the allotting of track on the third distance is decided by the ranking after two distances for each 5 year age group, and not by the ranking in the joined, neighbored groups.

The final distance drawing and classification must be done in her/his own age group independent of the number of participants in that age group. However, skaters in groups with odd number of participants, who in this case would skate alone on the last distance, may be paired together on the last distance.

The winner of the four-distance competition in his/her age group is the skater who has completed all distances successfully and has obtained the lowest total of points in his/her five year age group.

8. Prizes and Results of the Four-Distance Combination

For the four-distance combination, the first three competitors of a five-year age group will be awarded a prize.

All participants who finish all four distances of the competition successfully, without being disqualified, obtain a certificate and a medal.

The complete protocol with results with lap times, accumulated lap times and end times can be found at the Organizing Committee's web-site (www.kolomna-speed-skating.com). Every participant will receive a souvenir at the registration (included in the entry fee).

9. Doping control

Anti-doping tests may be carried out in accordance with ISU Rule 139.

10. Liability

In accordance with ISU Rule 119, ISU, IMSSC and the Organizing Committee assume **no responsibility for, or liability with respect to, bodily or personal injury, or property damages**, incurred in connection with this competition. Each skater or accompanying person is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage there to.

11. Entries

Entries must be made by filling out Entry Forms and send to Organizing Committee skate-mr@mail.ru

The registration deadline is February 18th at 12:00, for all Nations.

You will get a confirmation by e-mail, stating that your registration has been received by the Organizing Committee.

12. Confirmation of Participation

A competitor is obliged to confirm his participation in person at the latest one hour before the first Team Leader Meeting of the competition. If the competitor is not able to confirm in person, he must inform the competition organisation via e-mail (skate-mr@mail.ru), phone, SMS or WhatsApp +7 916 684 65 03(Mr. Boris Repnin) specifying first and last name at the latest 24 hours before the drawing of the competition.

13. Entry Fee

The entry fee is **4000 Russian Roubles (ap. 50 €) per person.**

The entry fee has to be paid not later than February 18th (= registration deadline).

14. COVID-19 rules

The current official regulations on Covid-19 allow the competition to take place.

We have published the applicable requirements and information on the Speed Skating Centre «Kolomna» website.

In case of a new situation with the possible ban on holding the competition, we will refund the paid fees.

Further claims for damage against the organizer will be rejected
